Job Description

Title: Licensed Occupational Therapist (OT)
Department: Rehabilitation
Reports to: Director, Patient Care Services

Job Summary: The Occupational Therapist, as an integral member of the interdisciplinary team, will provide effective evaluation and treatment of patients in order to promote or restore their highest functional status in accordance with physicians orders. A patient receives an occupational therapy evaluation upon physicians prescription to determine deficit areas. An individualized plan of care is established to focus on improving specific deficits.

Principal Duties and Responsibilities:

Responsibilities:

1. Evaluate and treat patients with physical and functional disorders including, activities of daily living training, perceptual retraining, functional cognitive retraining, visual retraining, muscle re-education, positioning, serial casting, splinting, wheelchair mobility, home evaluation.
2. Maintain complete patients records.
3. Participate in patient care conferences, family meetings team conferences and related staff conferences.
4. Conduct in-service training programs for hospital staff regarding occupational therapy services.
5. Maintain and increase professional competency by continued education.
6. Participate in discharge planning.
7. Complete appropriate Occupational Therapy charges rendered each month, including billing for adaptive equipment, casting/splinting, etc.

Minimum Qualifications:

1. Degree from an accredited program in Occupational Therapy.
 1. Current registration from the AOTA (American Occupational Therapy Association).
 2. Clinical pediatric experience with a variety of physical disorders with a strong neurological background.
 3. Good organizational, time management, verbal and written skills.
 4. Skills and expertise in current evaluation and remediation techniques for physically handicapped children.
 5. Communicates effectively with patients, hospital staff, and families.
 6. Current California State License in Occupational Therapy from the Board of Medical Quality Assurance.

Physical Requirements:

1. Physical strength and mobility to meet demands of job. Able to meet employee health requirements.
