1. Master's Degree in Speech Pathology.
2. Current California State License in Speech Pathology from the Board of Medical Quality Assurance.
3. Clinical experience in a variety of communication disorders.
4. Good organizational, time management, verbal and written communication.
5. Skills and expertise in current evaluation and remediation techniques for communicatively handicapped individuals.
6. Communicates effectively with patients, hospital staff.

Physical Requirements:

1. Physical strength and mobility to meet demands of the job. Able to meet employee health requirements.
2. Vision and Hearing adequate to perform job requirements.

Hours:

1. Flexible hours as agreed upon by the Administration.

Responsible To:

1. Administration.

Duties and Responsibilities:

1. Evaluate and treat patients with communication and/or swallowing disorders.
2. Participate in patient care conferences, family meetings, team conferences and related staff conferences.
3. Maintain complete patient records.
4. Complete appropriate Speech Pathology charges rendered each month.
5. Conduct in-service training programs for hospital staff regarding communication and/or dysphagia.
6. Maintain and increase professional competency by continued education.
7. Participate in discharge planning.
